Adaptive Lighting at New Central Bus Station

At the new central bus station (ZOB) in Achim, Germany, the O-Space luminaire by Bergmeister Leuchten was installed in 2024. The luminaires as well as the project's lighting concept were developed by OC | Lichtplanung; Frenz Landschaftsarchitekten are responsible for the landscape design. O-Space features modular optics, adaptive light control, and environmental considerations such as reduced light pollution and insect-friendly colour temperatures. The luminaire can be used both in urban areas and in parks and is available in two sizes.

Climbing in the net

In Bad Dürrenberg, Germany, the “Gradengerüst” climbing structure features the Berliner Mesh – a system developed by manufacturer Berliner Seilfabrik. The mesh consists of 16 mm polyester-coated steel cables arranged to form large, uniformly tensioned nets. High and low anchor points shape a three-dimensional space with organic forms. Aluminium ball nodes connect the net without plastic parts. Add-ons such as rope ladders, hammocks, and rubber mats offer inclusive access and respond to net movements, integrating users into the play experience even from resting positions.
